MAY 22ND OPEN HOUSE

The Ethician Foundation Museum of Genocide and Mass Atrocities Perpetrated Against American Indians and Other Native Peoples will hold an "Open House" from 4 - 6 PM on May 22nd at 1501 University Avenue.

Every year on his birthday, Ethician Foundation President, George Russell, born on May 22nd 1945, promotes the opening of either a new museum or the establishment of another wildlife refuge or botanical preserve.

The latest museum is in one of the 12 historic properties in the George H. Russell and Suzanne B. Russell Museum District between 14th and 16th streets on University Avenue in Huntsville.

The Russell's have saved and preserved all three of the 1840's historic Homes in Huntsville that have not been vandalized or destroyed while "city leaders" promoted "growth and progress" at the expense of the historic and natural beauty and historic integrity of the "Mt. Vernon" and "Athens" of Texas. Tragically, the 1848 home designed and built under the supervision of Margaret Lea Houston was purposefully vandalized by convicts and converted into a log shack over 30 years ago.
